

# Waste Connections of Colorado

## Residential Trash and Recycling Guide

### Recycling

Waste Connections encourages its customers to recycle whenever possible to reduce costs, help conserve our country's natural resources and energy, and help reduce global warming.

**Glass, plastic, tin, and aluminum should be separated from the paper products. Waste Connections will provide one recycle container at no charge. Additional plastic tubs, containers, or bags for paper recycling may be used. Please place the recycle materials on the opposite side of the driveway or 8 to 10 feet away from the trash cart. Recycle pick-up is scheduled for the same day as trash service.**

#### Plastics

# 1 and # 2 plastic bottles. Please discard screw-on caps and pumps. **No** motor oil or hazardous materials containers. **No** foam, bags, or tubs.

#### Metals

Aluminum, tin, steel – please rinse cans if needed. **No** aerosol cans, hangers, nor wire.

#### Glass

Bottles and jars ok – please rinse if needed. **No** window or mirror glass, light bulbs, drinking glasses, vases, ceramics, cookware, or broken glass.

#### Paper Products

Newspaper, junk mail, office paper, magazines, catalogs, telephone books, paperboard (such as cereal boxes and tissue boxes), and paper bags.  
**No** wax coated or food contaminated boxes, pet food bags, tissues, napkins, or paper towels.  
Please secure the paper so the wind does not blow it around the neighborhood.

#### Corrugated Cardboard

Corrugated cardboard boxes should be flattened and cut to a size that will fit inside the Waste Connections recycle container. Corrugated cardboard may also be placed outside and next to the recycle containers. Please secure the cardboard to ensure that the wind does not blow it around the neighborhood.

#### Other

Milk cartons, juice boxes should be rinsed with any plastic caps, spouts, or straws removed.

### Trash Collection

***Trash and recycling should be at curbside by 7:00 am on scheduled pick-up days.***

The HOA pays for one 90 Gallon trash container and unlimited recycling per week.

Extra trash and large item removal can be arranged with a 24 hour advance call to Waste Connections. The extra charge will depend upon the amount and size of disposal.

**No** hazardous waste, aerosol, liquid paint, batteries, propane or other gas canisters, computer monitors, oil, or chemicals. Filling the container with dirt, sod, or rock could cause it to be too heavy for handling.

#### Collection for Holidays

If a holiday falls on or before your scheduled pick-up day, your collection will be delayed by one day. Holidays observed: Memorial, Independence, Labor, Thanksgiving, Christmas, New Year's.

A replacement fee will apply if a company owned container is lost or damaged beyond normal use and wear.
